SHORT ANNOUNCEMENT

VI Ukrainian Scientific and Technical Conference of Young Scientists in the Field of Metrology “Technical using of Measurement-2020”

Conference of young scientists in the field of metrology “Technical Using of Measurement-2020” was held at the “Lviv Polytechnic National University by Department of Information-measuring technologies, Febr. 04–07, 2020. Co-organizers of the conference were Academy of Metrology of Ukraine, Lviv Polytechnic National University, National Technical University of Ukraine “Kyiv Polytechnic Institute after I. Sikorsky”, State enterprise “Research Institute of Metrology of Measuring and Control Systems”.

The conference was attended by 147 specialists (scientists, engineers, graduate students, and students) in the field of metrology, standardization, certification and quality management. The plenary reports were concerned with the means of product quality assurance, the study of natural gas meters, the development, and testing of benchmarks for ultrasonic pressure unit reproduction, the metrological support of information-measuring systems, unmanned aerial vehicles, as well as the prospects of training the metrologists. The poster presentations of 19 young scientists, doctoral students, graduate students, and 23 students have reflected a wide range of issues related to the design and operation of measuring instruments.
